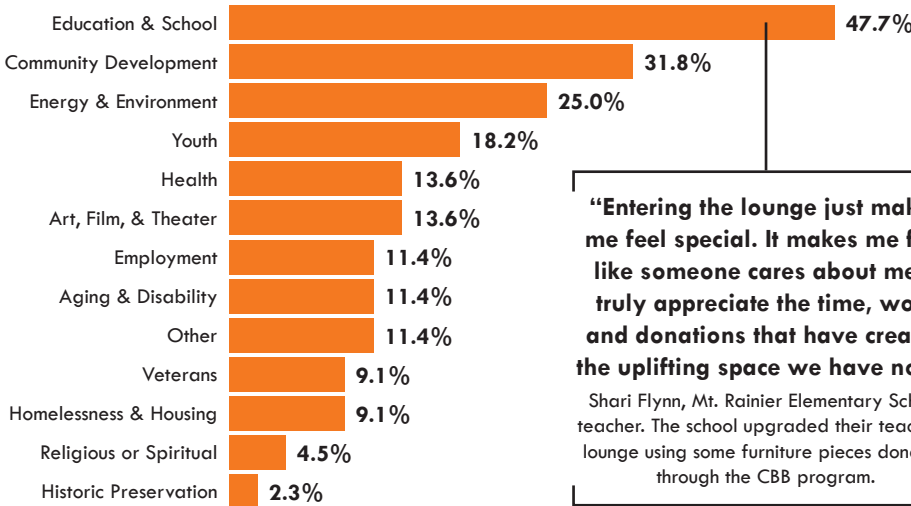

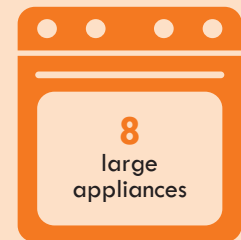

"Entering the lounge just makes me feel special. It makes me feel like someone cares about me. I truly appreciate the time, work and donations that have created the uplifting space we have now."

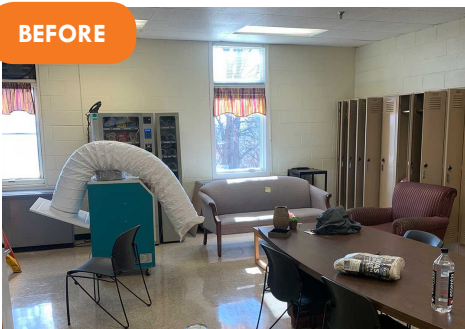
Shari Flynn, Mt. Rainier Elementary School teacher. The school upgraded their teacher's lounge using some furniture pieces donated through the CBB program.
